

CHUNK **(fast & easy)**



Note: Chunk does the twist. Block before sewing.

Finished Size:

9" x 21" (23 x 53.5 cm)

Materials:

- 1 ball of Rowan Big Wool (100g/87 yds) 100% Merino wool #035 Tremble
- Size 9mm (US 13) knitting needles. One large cable needle or double pointed needle.

Stitches:

C₄B = Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in the back. Knit next 2 sts from left hand needle, then K₂ from cable needle.

Yf = yarn forward.

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Instructions:

Cast on 42 sts.

Row 1: (RS) P₃. *K₄. P₃. Rep from * to end.

Row 2: K₁. Yf. K₂tog. *P₄. K₁. Yf. K₂tog. Rep from * to end.

Row 3: P₃. *C₄B. P₃. Rep from * to end.

Row 4: As Row 2.

Row 5: As Row 1.

Row 6: As Row 2.

These 6 rows form Pat. Cont in Pat until work from beg measures 21" (53.5 cm). Bind off. Sew together.
