(Easy)

Size

80 x 7 ins [203 x 18 cm]

Materials

Needful Yarns Ker (1.75oz/50g) (#712 blue) 4 balls

Size 6.5 mm (U.S. 10.5) crochet hook or size needed to obtain tension.

Tension

11 sc and 12 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] 13 ch and 8 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in pat

Instructions

Beginning at side edge, ch 27. **Row 1:** (RS) 1 sc in 6th ch from hook *5 ch. Skip 3 ch. 1 sc into next ch; rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: *5 ch. 1 sc into next 5 ch arch; rep from * to end, turn. Rep Row 2 until work from beg measures 80 ins [203 cm]. Fasten off.



Fringe:

Cut 2 lengths of 11 ins [28 cm]. Fold the strands in half. With the RS facing, insert the crochet hook from the WS to the RS at the corner of scarf. With crochet hook, catch the yarn at the fold and pull through. Use the crochet hook to pull the ends of the fringe through the loop. Pull the ends of the fringe to tighten. Trim the fringe. Add 1 fringe to each arch.
